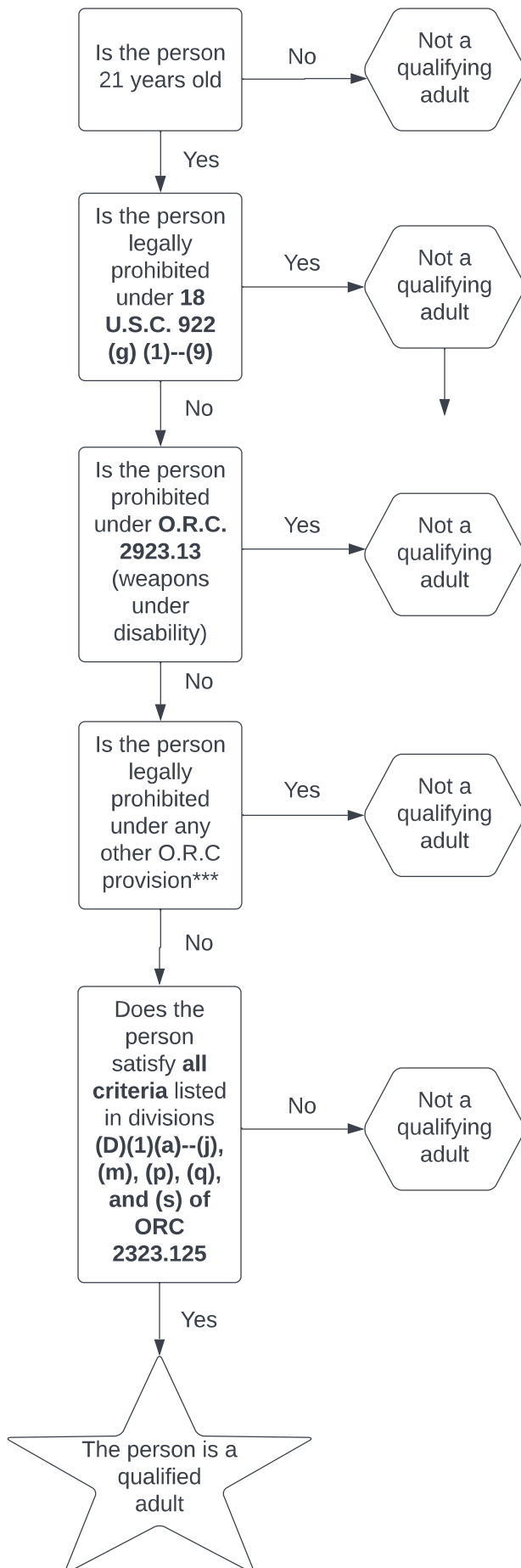


Who is a "Qualifying Adult"?

Senate Bill 215: Effective June 12, 2022



You can carry a firearm concealed, in a vehicle, on a boat, wherever you're legally permitted to as long as you're a **"qualifying adult"**.

Prohibited under 18 U.S.C. 922(g)(1)–(9):

1. Been convicted of an F4 or higher;
2. Is a fugitive from justice;
3. Is an unlawful user of a scheduled drug (I–V) including marijuana;
4. Has been adjudicated as mentally defective or who has been committed to a mental institution;
5. a) illegally or unlawfully in the United States; or (b) has been admitted to the United States under a nonimmigrant visa;
6. Has been dishonorably discharged from the Armed Forces;
7. A US citizen has renounced citizenship;
8. Subject to a court order that A) was issued after hearing, after actual notice, and where the person had an opportunity to participate; B) restrains someone from harassing, stalking, or threatening an intimate partner or a child of intimate partner, or engaging in other conduct that would place an intimate partner in reasonable fear of bodily injury to the partner or child; AND C) includes a finding that such person represents a credible threat to the physical safety of the intimate partner or child; or explicitly prohibits the use, attempted use, or threatened use of physical force against such intimate partner or child that would reasonably be expected to cause bodily injury; or
9. Who has been convicted in any court of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence (includes any misdemeanor offense of violence against a family or household member, except against siblings).

Prohibited under O.R.C. 2923.13:

1. Fugitive from justice (includes a warrant on indictment, or if after you flee from police you know they are looking for you, etc.);
2. Under indictment or convicted of a felony offense of violence (includes juvenile adjudications);
3. Under indictment or convicted for felony drug offense (includes juvenile adjudications);
4. Drug dependent, in danger of drug dependence, or a chronic alcoholic;
5. Mental incompetence.

Satisfies all criteria listed in divisions (D)(1)(a) to (j), (m), (p), (q), and (s) of section 2923.125: CCW license can be issued if all apply:

1. Person is legally living in US;
2. Is at least twenty-one years of age;
3. Not a fugitive of justice;
4. Not under **indictment** for or otherwise **charged** with: a felony; an offense (including misdemeanors) involving the illegal possession, use, sale, administration, or distribution of or trafficking in a drug of abuse; a misdemeanor **offense of violence, negligent assault, or falsification of a CCW license**;
5. **Not convicted of or pleaded guilty** (or adjudicated a delinquent child) to: a felony that involves the illegal possession, use, sale, administration, or distribution of or trafficking in a drug of abuse; **assault on a peace officer**; and any other misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for more than one year;
6. **Within three years**, has not been **convicted of or pleaded guilty** (or adjudicated a delinquent child) to **amisdemeanor offense of violence**;
7. **Within five years**, has not been **convicted of, pleaded guilty to, or adjudicated a delinquent child for committing two or more violations of assault or negligent assault**;
8. **Within ten years**, has not been convicted of, pleaded guilty to, or adjudicated a delinquent child for **Resisting Arrest**;
9. Has not been adjudicated as a mental defective, not been committed to any mental institution, not under adjudication of mental incompetence, not been found by a court to be a mentally ill person subject to court order, and not an involuntary patient other than one who is a patient only for purposes of observation;
10. Not currently subject to a **civil protection order, a temporary protection order, or a protection order issued by a court of another state**;
11. Not currently subject to a CCW suspension that was previously issued;
12. Cannot be an alien and admitted to the United States under a nonimmigrant visa;
13. Not dishonorably discharged US armed forces;
14. Not convicted of, pleaded guilty to, or adjudicated a delinquent child for all **Domestic Violence** (includes M1's, M2's, M4's).

***Not Listed: Is the person legally prohibited under any other O.R.C provision
